# Course Fee

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**There is no course fee required for joining this course. By joining this course, participants will have access to :**

1. Airport travels from Juanda International Airport (SUB) on 4th November 2024 to the students dorm and Universitas Negeri Malang, and from Malang to Juanda International Airport (SUB) on Friday 8th or Saturday 9th November 2024. Any travel outside the scheduled arrangement should be first discussed with the committee to confirm its sponsorship.
2. Accommodation is provided for the check in on 4th November and check out on 9th November morning.
3. Breakfast, lunch, and snacks are provided on 5th-8th November
4. Dinner is provided on 5th and 7th November
5. On the days of arrival and departure, meals are not provided.
6. City trip and all local transports following the course schedule are provided
7. All courses that require practices and equipment such as Cooking and Batik class are fully covered.

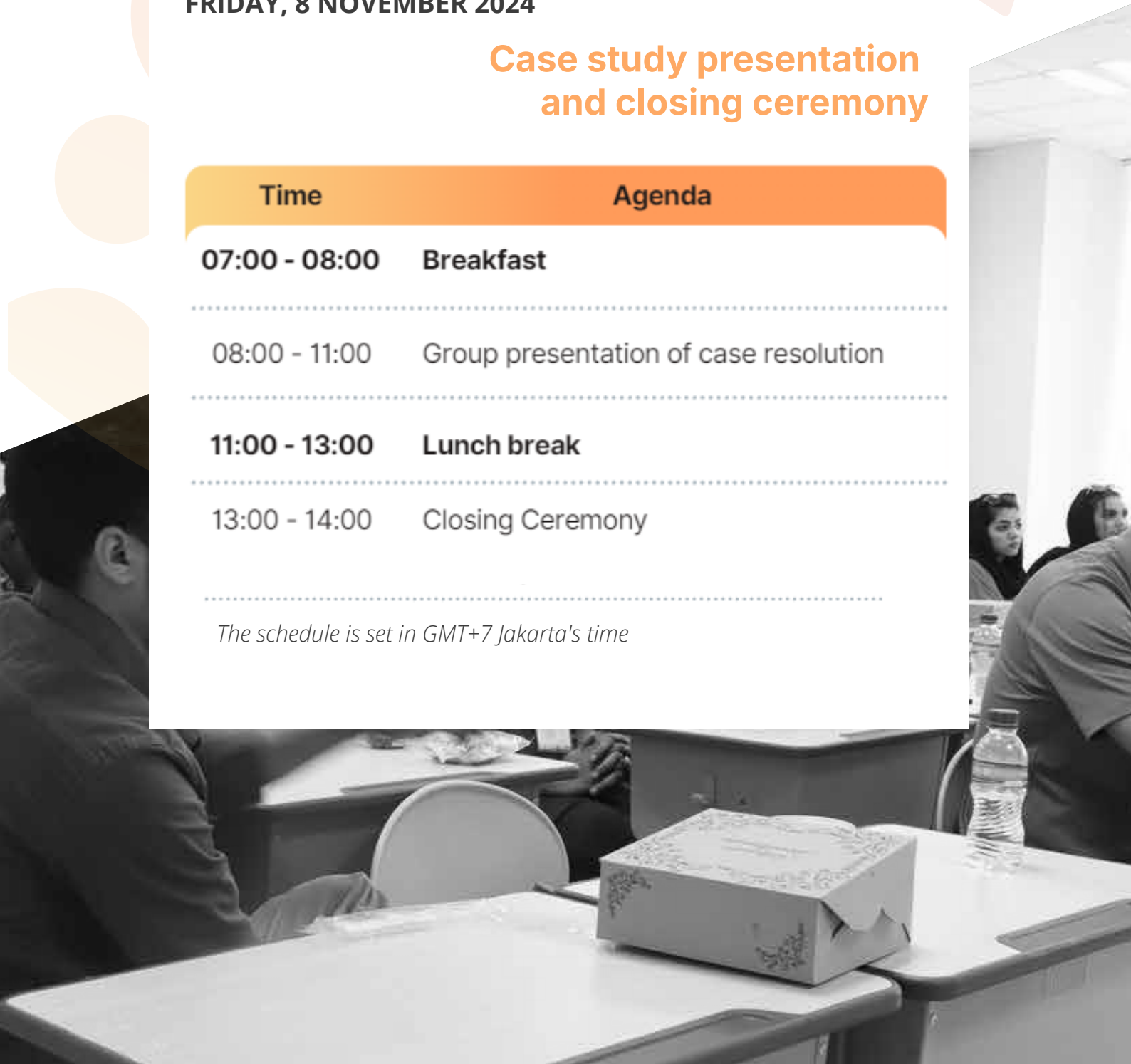
